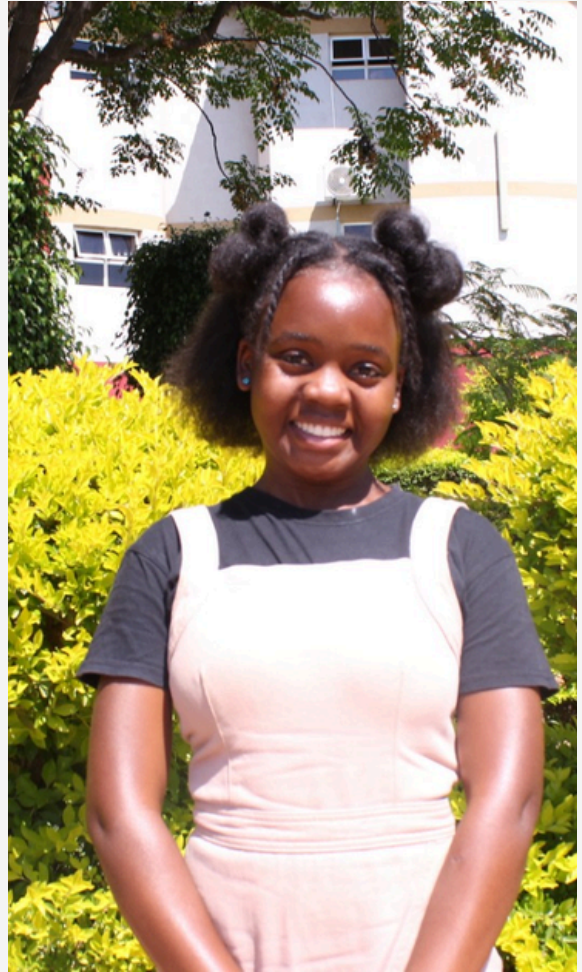
A
